Dear North Immanuel Families,

Grace and Peace from our Risen Lord Jesus be with you all! Amen.

It is about time for us to wrap up our Ten Commandments series.

What are the Ninth and the Tenth Commandments?

You shall not covet your neighbors' house.

You shall not covet your neighbors' wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

What do they mean?

Answer: We should fear and love God that we may not craftily seek to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, and obtain it by a show of [justice and] right, etc., but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

We should fear and love God that we may not estrange, force, or entice away our neighbor's wife, servants, or cattle, but urge them to stay and [diligently] do their duty.

What is coveting?

Coveting is the sinful desire in our hearts to acquire for ourselves anything that belongs to our neighbor. It is also the desire to draw away from our neighbor for our own benefit anyone who is important to our neighbor (a spouse, friends, and so on).

How do we fear and love God in keeping the ninth and the ten commandments?

First, we fear and love God by not coveting the gifts that He has given to our neighbors.

Second, we fear and love God by being satisfied with what God has provided us and others.

Let us pray:

Heavenly Father, you open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living creature. Cause us to fear and love you above all things, that our hearts would not covet that which you have given to our neighbors. Rather, lead us to trust in your provision of daily bread, be content with what you provide, and reject every evil scheme or enticement that would secure for ourselves what which you have given to others. Enable us to serve our neighbors by helping them keep and guard all that you have given to them; through Jesus Christ, our Lord Amen.

Pastor Isaiah opened the meeting with prayer.

Pastor's report: Pastor continues doing visitation in Fergus Falls, Pelican Rapids, Barnesville and Fargo. Two applications for membership were received. Dates were provided to prepare for coverage for residency commitment (5/14-5/27) and vacation (8/9-8/16), so a substitute will be needed on 5/21/23 and 8/13/23. Names were discussed of possible coverage. A meeting with Pastor, Donna, Lois and Robbie set for 4/19 to discuss Christian Education information.

The power of (God's) light

Do most people truly feel happier in spring? Is the light brighter, the sky bluer? Meteorologists say yes. The shorter, blue wavelengths of sunlight scatter more efficiently than long, red ones; as the sun rises higher in spring, the light passes through less atmosphere, making the sky appear bluer. Outdoor levels of light have proven as effective as Prozac to combat depression — and May is the sunniest month!

The Bible frequently uses light as a metaphor for God: "The Lord is my light and my salvation" (Psalm 27:1); "Let us walk in the light of the Lord" (Isaiah 2:5); "The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world" (John 1:9). Darkness isn't bad; seeds sprout in dark soil, life begins in the dark womb, and darkness protected the Hebrews fleeing Pharaoh and the holy family fleeing Herod.

But light is one apt image for God because most of us know the joy, health and energy light brings. Both in spring and through faith in the God who enlightens all, may we "live as children of light" (Ephesians 5:8).
