The meeting was called to order by Grant Meyer at 6:42 p.m.

Pastor Roger led us in devotions. 2nd Corinthians

Treasurers Report – Shared by Grant Meyer. Shyla not present. Placed on file.

Leon Dunham made a motion to accept Secretary report. Nolan Dunham 2nd. Motion carried.
