Saint Valentine (also Valentinus) refers to one of several martyred saints of ancient Rome. The feast of St. Valentine was first decreed in 496 by Pope Gelasius I. Many of the current legends that characterize Saint Valentine were invented in the fourteenth century in England, notably by Geoffrey Chaucer, when the feast day of February 14 first became associated with romantic love.

And although today our culture is preoccupied with red roses, hearts, and chocolates, the original feast day was set aside to honor the martyrs' love for Jesus and His Church.

And their love was not based on emotions, but the agape love which is an unconditional, self-giving love. According to psychiatrist, M. Scott Peck, "This kind of love is not a feeling... Genuine love is volitional rather than emotional. The person who truly loves does so because of a decision to love."

A quote that I use in nearly every wedding ceremony is from Dietrich Bonhoeffer. He was in prison when his sister was married and he wrote these words to her, "It

is not your love that sustains the marriage, but from now on the marriage that sustains your love." A relationship will often begin with romantic feelings, but marriage is built on a promise – a decision to love, not fleeting infatuation. There is a poem that expresses this truth. "Feelings come and feelings go and feelings are deceiving, it is the promise that you make to me that will keep my heart believing."

Marriage is a symbol of God's covenant with His people. Several times in the Old Testament God uses the imagery of a marital relationship to describe His relationship with His people. In Hosea God says, "And I will make for you a covenant on that day... and I will betroth you to Me forever." (2:18-19)

For us Christians 'that day' is the day of Jesus Christ, who is the Bridegroom. Several times in the New Testament, Jesus refers to Himself as the Bridegroom and the church as His bride. In 2 Corinthians, Paul writes that "we have been betrothed to Christ as a pure bride to her one husband." In Ephesians, he explains that "Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water (baptism) through the word, and to present her to Himself as a radiant church."

Martin Luther understood that love was volitional and demanded commitment. Yet he also experienced the emotional side of love. In reference to his wife, Katie, said, "There is no bond on earth so sweet, nor any separation so bitter, as that which occurs in a good marriage."

This Valentine's Day, remember God's promise of love toward you. God has made a covenant of love for us in Jesus Christ, and He will never break it.

The meeting was called to order by Grant Meyer at 7:05 p.m.

Pastor Nate led us in devotions. "Names"

Treasurers Report – The budget, final expenses, income and investments were shared with the council in Shyla's absence.

A motion was made by Leon Dunham to set Pastor Nate Bjore's housing allowance at \$28,000.00 and salary at \$22,000.00. Duane Ishaug 2<sup>nd</sup> motion. Motion carried.

The budget was discussed and some changes were made to the preliminary budget to present to the congregation at the annual meeting.

Secretary's report. Leon Dunham 1<sup>st</sup>, Becky Lage 2<sup>nd</sup> motion. Motion carried.

Pastoral Report – He has done some visits. Nursing home services were done. Wrote an article for The Pelican Press. Discussed Lenten services.

Committees –

**Worship** – Sign up sheet for February Meals on Wheels delivery in the back of the church. Lenten services no Good Friday service. Decision will be made on holding council meeting during Lent at February meeting. Outdoor worship dates discussed. We held 2 in June, 1 in July and 1 in August last year. We will see if the Granders want to play this summer and what Sunday they would like. Do we want to schedule MN Teen Challenge Choir this spring?

**Stewardship** – Christmas service was well attended.

**Education** – We have started classes again. We will end the year on the first Sunday in May. Confirmation will be held on Palm Sunday. There will be six students confirmed.

**Property and Management** – Nolan Dunham had someone from Wester Siding give him a quote on residing the church where the paint is bad. The estimate was \$50,975.00. He will verify the area that would be done for that. He plans to get some bids on what it would cost to paint the peeling siding. Insurance company will give us \$5700.00. Nolan has also been visiting with the highway department to see if we could get some reduced speed or caution signs on the highway near the church.

**New Business** –






