Church Council Minutes September 6, 2023

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. Present: Pastor Isaiah, Brad Knorr, Dave Dunham, Steve Strandlien, Becky Lage, Donna Dunham, Wayne Hovland, Bonnie Harry, Robbie Shulstad, and Brenda Haugrud. Absent: Tanner Nelson

Pastor opened the meeting with prayer.

Pastor's report: Pastor presented to the council his orders for Boot Camp for Chaplins in Fort Jackson in Columbia, SC. He will be gone from September 9-December 18. He provided an income comparison sheet for council to use as a tool to consider supplementary pay while he is away, noting that even though he will be paid from the military there is about a thousand dollar deficit when considering his current income from NI, hospice and the guard. Council will discuss this after the pastor is excused from the meeting.

Also, pastor spoke with the parents of the confirmands and they agreed that confirmation will be deferred until he gets back.

Secretary's report: read, accepted and placed on file.

Treasurer's report: Council reviewed the treasurer's report and placed on file, noting that propane and other regular expenses had been paid for from a \$5000 transfer to the account.

Committee reports:

Evangelism Committee: Bonnie reported that pulpit supply for Sunday, September 10 has been arranged; a few names were given to her by Pastor Isaiah for fill-in, and one pastor in particular mentioned that he would be willing to fill in for funerals, pulpit supply, and visitation during pastor Isaiah's absence. Council discussed the importance of continuity. Pastor gave Bonnie a list of visitation names and addresses to pass along to the fill-in Pastor.

Stewardship: nothing new to report

Christian Education: Rally Sunday is set for September 17 with potluck following the service.

Donna mentioned the possibility of another Pray and Paint session this fall or winter.

Property and Management: the floor in the sacristy is done, and the window renovation will start in October and will take about 6 to 8 weeks.

Old Business: nothing to report

New Business: September 18 the furnace will get a seasonal check-up, and September 27 the pianos will get tuned. Benevolence was tabled until October 11. Wayne made a motion to purchase the kids' Christmas activity bags, Becky 2nd, motion carried.

The council also agreed that we should arrange for the Granders to perform on the Wednesday after Thanksgiving.

Following the discussion of the information given to the council from Pastor regarding income during his absence, a motion was made by Steve to pay the Pastor his full salary through September and prorate December's salary. This closes the gap mentioned earlier between the military payments and Pastor's regular monthly income. Dave seconded the motion, motion carried. Brad will tell the pastor of the decision following tonight's meeting.

Motion made to adjourn by Steve, seconded by Becky, carried.
